This concept is getting more popular, and has many applications.

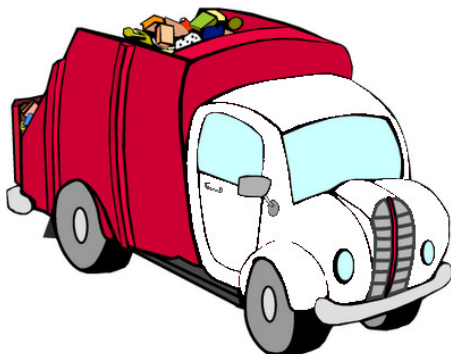
These cans can roll, and can be easily fork-lifted around the job site.

Employee Spotlight



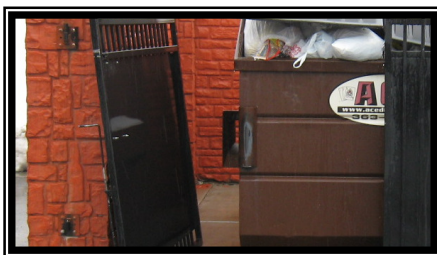

Parents Empowered

Ace Disposal has teamed up with Parents Empowered to benefit a cause that is becoming more of a problem every year. Underage drinking is affecting kids all across the nation, and we feel that it is important to spread the word to parents and adults across Utah. Parents Empowered focuses on eliminating underage drinking in Utah, since kids are drinking as young as eight years old. If kids are drinking at such a young age, they are risking the chance of seriously damaging their short or long term growth of the brain. There are the common reasons why underage drinking is bad, but

one of the main problems is drinking and driving. We all know victims of drinking and driving, and they are most common with underage drinking. New scientific evidence has shown that the human brain is still maturing until the age of 21. Drinking alcohol as a teen effects the brain differently than an adult brain because the teen's brain is still developing. Alcohol can affect a teen for up to two weeks after they have drunk. With that result, underage drinking has the ability to affect children's social skills, motor skills, and good judgment. Drinking increases the risk of mental illness, and highly increases the risk of becoming an alcoholic. With the problems that are rising with underage

drinking, Ace wants to help in any way possible. We will continue to put signs on our trucks to remind parents to talk to their kids about drinking, if it is a way that we can help. We hope that parents realize the severity of this issue and take the extra precautions to help their kids when dealing with such issues.
