Why do you ask for my First & Last name?

A:


Depending on the nature of the call there are different reasons we ask for your name.

- If you are calling for an extra pick up we ask for the requestors first and last so it will show on the invoice attached to the charge for your information.
- We sometimes need to call customers back and it is helpful to have the last name because you may share your first name with a few others in your building.

There are many items that are thrown into the recycle bins that are actually not recyclable. Please help us keep the contamination to a minimum. Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Do I need to rinse out the containers?

A: It doesn't hurt to rinse, but it's not necessary. Please make sure that the containers are emptied completely.

Q: Do I bag my recycle items?

A: You don't need to bag your items, but if you do please leave the bags untied.

Small recyclables such as shredded paper or packaging peanuts should be bagged to prevent them from creating a mess.

Q: Can I recycle plastic shopping bags?

A: This item sometimes causes problem for the recycler because they are smaller and get caught in the sorting machines.

To help prevent this from happening you can place all bags into one and loosely tie closed.

Q: Why is glass on the unacceptable list?

A: Currently the recycle facility Ace Disposal takes recycle materials does not accept glass. There are recycle bins for glass placed throughout the city (*for residential use*)

Q: What do you mean by clean paper plates, clean aluminum foil and clean Styrofoam?

(These items can be found on the flyer)

A: By clean we mean cleared of all food and liquid by scraping everything off.

**Please make sure that you do not place plates and cups that have absorbed food/ liquid.*

Q: What do I do with packaging that has plastic and cardboard?

A: If possible pull the different material apart before you toss it in the bin. This will help insure that the items are correctly disposed of at the recycle facility.
