Ace Disposal has been working with Midgley Construction to build the best energy efficient building we could have asked for. Our building has amazing features. We are the first private business in the Salt Lake Valley to put a Geothermal heating and cooling system into the ground below the building and shop areas to help heat and cool. We will reduce our fossil fuel usage and our carbon footprint. To give an overview of this system, there are pipes (see picture) placed all along the floor of the building below the actual flooring. There is antifreeze that runs thru the pipes that takes the temperature from the earth (around 60 degrees year round) and sends it upwards. With this system we will have less of a need to run an air conditioner in the summer or heater in the winter. We also have this throughout the sidewalks to alleviate the need for plowing which is always a nice feature in Utah.



The building also has many windows to let in natural light so we don't use as much artificial lighting. All the windows are 'E' rated, which means they trap the heat and cool in depending on the seasons.

# Compressed Natural Gas Trucks

There are so many benefits to having a natural gas vehicle for drivers today. Ace Disposal currently has 6 trucks total with more on the way. Five are dedicated CNG and one is a Hybrid CNG Diesel. You will recognize them with the CNG sticker on the back of the vehicle. We run these trucks in the Salt Lake Valley for residential and commercial services. The power is comparable to diesel fueled trucks, with less noise from the engine and much cleaner smoke coming from the exhaust. Our CNG trucks are using roughly 33% more fuel per day, but the price of gas is roughly \$1.00 per gallon compared to \$2.50 per gallon for diesel. The more we understand how important CNG vehicles are the better off our environment is. With alternative fuel technologies we will help reduce the dependence on foreign oil.

It is a very exciting time for Ace Disposal right now. We are trying our hardest to become as environmentally friendly as possible. With our CNG vehicles, recycling programs across the Wasatch Front, and our energy efficient building we are off on a fantastic start. We hope we can be a good example to those around us in helping our community become greener.
